**Transfer:** VIP participants using the official BSF hotel reservation get free

transfer from Bergen Airport/Flesland to hotel on Thursday and back to the airport on the day of departure. Look for our staff holding BSF signs after you have passed through customs. The meet office will have the times participants will be picked up at the hotel on their departure day,

so please ask at some point during the weekend.

# A & B Flight

The fastest heats in each event will be swam at the start of the morning session.

**A-flight** will contain the following heats in the different events.

50m: 6 heats + heat 7 (Norwegian junior final) 100: 5 heats + heat 6 (Norwegian junior final) 200: 4 heats + heat 5 (Norwegian Junior Finals) 400: 3 heats + heat 4 (Norwegian junior final)

After the A-flight the **B-flight** will be conducted in the usual order.

# In the 25 m diving pool.

During the competition the 25m diving pool can be used as a warm up and cool down pool. Please note: the pool is located right beside the competition pool, so please no loud sounds, whistling or screaming during completion times

# Warm up in the competition pool

Thursday 14.00 - 20.00

Friday to Sunday: A-flight: 0700-0845

B-flight: 1 hour right after the A-flight.

Finals: From B-flights ends until 1650(1550 on Sunday).

Throughout the competition, the plunge pool can

be used for warm up and warm down.

Monday until Wednesday, by appointment

# **Team Leader** meeting:

A team leader from each country/club and Norwegian club teams are requested to attend the team meeting to be held Thursday April 4, 20.00 in the AdO arena meeting room. There will be signs showing the way to the location.

# Withdrawls:

You can mail in withdrawls to stevnebergen@gmail.com. The deadline for withdrawls to (800/1500) is at the team leaders meeting. The deadline for withdrawls to morning sessions is 2000 hrs the night before. Withdrawls for the finals need to be made to the meet office no later than 30 minutes after the end of the morning session. You can deliver the withdrawls electronically with team code that can be requested from the meet office

# 800/1500 m freestyle:

4x100 Medley relay The events will be seeded and swam as a timed final. Only the 8 swimmers/teams with the 8 fastest entry times are in this final. This is an open final so both junior and senior swimmers are included. # Prize money: In each final event:

Senior

Winner kr. 3000,- Second kr. 1250,- Third kr. 750,-

Junior -

Winner kr. 500,- Second kr. 300,- Third kr. 200,-

Handicap-

Winner kr 500,-, Second kr 300,- Third kr 200,-

In case of a tie in any race, the prize money will be shared (i.e. if there are two 1st places, then no 2nd place prize money will be awarded). The total of kr. 3250,- will be equally shared between the two (2) winners, (that is kr. 1625,-each.)

The top three senior and junior performances, (counting the three best results from FINA's table) earn prize money:

Senior -

First place kr. 10.000,-Second place kr. 5000,-Third place kr. 2500,- Junior – (combined women and men)

First place kr. 5000,-Second place kr. 2500,-Third place kr. 1250,-

# **Nordic Swim Tour 2019:**

It is a pleasure to introduce the collaboration between Helsinki Swim Meet(1th-2th of April), Bergen Swim Festival 2019(5.th-7.th.) and Swim Open Stockholm(12.th-15.th) of April 2019.

As a result of the collaboration there is an attractive opportunity for the top swimmers to win extra prize monies if you participate in the same event both in Sweden and Norway. Then the score from FINA's table in one of the following events will be added and we will have a winner of the Nordic swim tour 2019.
